

# Tommy's First Bike

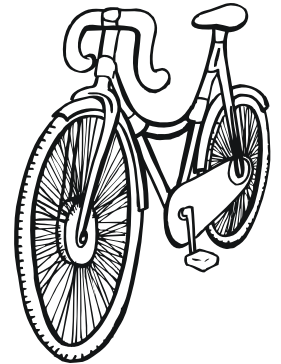
## Sales Tax
